

New Mexico Outdoor Heritage Foundation (NMOHF) was formed by SFWNM board members to preserve the heritage that has been passed down through the years, from one generation to the next; to continue the Legacy for generations to come. Education as well as providing the means and opportunities is the key to assure that this Legacy continues. Everyone has the right to enjoy Gods creation in the outdoors, by respecting his creations and each other's personal beliefs and working together we will assure that future generations can continue to enjoy what we have today.

NMOHF Is working towards providing the education on a grand scale to outdoors to the classroom; having partnered with Dallas Ecological Foundation (DEF) we have brought their "Outdoor Adventures Program" (ODAP) to New Mexico. A pilot program was started in the 2016–2017 school year with a few schools in New Mexico participating and several more in the process. SFWNM provided the funds to get the DEF classroom curriculum re-written to New Mexico standards so that the ODAP can be taught in New Mexico Middle and High Schools NMOHF's goal is to have every Middle & High School teaching the

program in the next few years.
